

CHOIR DIRECTOR (8-10 hrs/wk)

Ministry Focus: The ministry focus of the Choir Director shall be to enhance the worship experience and facilitate greater participation through the leadership of special groups, such as Sanctuary Choir, Handbell Choirs, and other groups yet undefined.

Qualifications: The Choir Director should have previous experience in directing vocal choirs and ensembles and should preferably have some experience with playing in and/or directing Handbells.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Sanctuary Choir (August – May)
 - Lead weekly rehearsals
 - Direct in weekly worship
- Handbells (both adult & youth)
 - Lead weekly rehearsals
 - Direct in worship monthly
- Children’s Chimes and other choirs
 - As interest dictates, lead additional groups such as Children’s Chimes, Youth Choir, and Children’s Choir (currently, none of these are active groups)
 - Direct groups in worship, as opportunity dictates
- Collaborate closely with Director of Worship, Music, and Arts in planning, choosing, and scheduling music for groups to present during worship.
- Purchase and organize all music assigned to groups and maintain music files
- Attend worship planning meetings as available.
