### **It is NOT a Mission Trip**

The Tanzanian leaders of the Northern Diocese serve as our hosts, showing us the diverse ministries of the Diocese: schools, hospitals, parishes, clinics, orphanages, services to the poor and handicapped. It is primarily about relationship. You will return having friends in Tanzania.

### **It is NOT just for Nebraska Lutherans**

Participants in vision trips come from all over the country and from many different religious traditions. We will, however, participate in

Lutheran services and walk as Christian brothers and sisters. Trips are open to adults and adolescents 16 or over who seek to learn. They are not suitable for young children.

### **But there is more!**

In addition to the chance to see the work of the Northern Diocese, make new friends, and open your eyes to a culture much different than any other – we spend a week on safari seeing the glory of God's creation such as can be experienced nowhere else on earth.

Trips are capped at 20 participants.
