Job Summary

The Mission Coordinator is responsible for assisting the Director of Mission Ministries in administering and executing outreach programs and partnerships enabling the Bethany Faith Family to carry forward our vision to "bless". Supports a culture of service and compassion to those outside our faith community. Assists the Director of Mission Ministries with planning and coordinating Mission fundraiser events.

Essential Job Function:

- 1. Schedule, organize and execute the day-to-day operations of Bethany's mission programs and partnerships.
- 2. Collaborate with all ministries of the church in the development of or partnerships in relevant mission activities for those ministries. (E.g. outreach activities for VBS, Sunday School, etc.).
- 3. Coordinate adult mission/service opportunities, events, and ministries.
- 4. Manage and track volunteer hours and mission financial accounts and prepare reports as needed.
- 5. Develop plan and implement mission ministry's communication strategy for the Bethany website, newsletters, social media, etc. in coordination with the communication team.
- 6. Plan, organize, and execute mission fundraisers currently including gala and golf tournament.
- 7. Help recruit, manage coach and care for all mission servants and leaders.
